



## ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

1. A recipient of an athletic scholarship must be academically eligible for the total sport season for which the scholarship was awarded. Standards for eligibility are set forth by the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) and Garrett College.
2. If a student/athlete on scholarship is injured in a practice session or game situation and this injury prohibits the athlete from further participation, he/she will retain the scholarship for the period for which it was awarded. He/She will be given a work assignment in the Department of Athletics assigned by the Director of Athletics. The recipient will retain the scholarship only if the work assignment is carried out.
3. If a student/athlete on scholarship develops an illness after he/she is actively involved in athletics at Garrett College and this illness prohibits him/her from further participation in athletics, he/she will retain the scholarship for the period for which it was awarded. He/she will be given a work assignment in the Department of Athletics assigned by the Director of Athletics. The recipient will retain the scholarship only if the work assignment is carried out.
4. If a student/athlete receives a scholarship and then, in the opinion of the coach, the athlete's athletic skills do not meet the team standards and is cut from the team, he/she will retain the scholarship for the period for which it was awarded. He/She will be given a work assignment in the Department of Athletics assigned by the Director of Athletics. The recipient will retain the scholarship only if the work assignment is carried out.
5. If a student/athlete is eliminated from an athletic team for disciplinary reasons, the athlete will lose his/her scholarship immediately. Disciplinary reasons may include any violations of the Garrett College Student Code of Conduct listed in the college catalog as well as failure to meet the prescribed standards set forth by the Garrett College Student Athlete Code of Conduct or specific sport team rules designated by the individual coach. Such standards must be made known to all team members.
6. A recipient who has signed an NJCAA National Letter of Intent MUST arrive on campus physically able to compete in athletics. Failure to do so may result in loss of the athletic scholarship.
7. If a recipient for an athletic scholarship decides that he/she does not wish to continue to participate in the sport for which the scholarship is designated, the scholarship will cease to exist from the day he/she quits the team.
8. It is important for the student/athlete to realize that signature on the NJCAA National Letter of Intent form is a binding agreement. It is further to be understood that it is the responsibility of the student/athlete to make restitution to the college for all college costs incurred if an athletic scholarship is withdrawn for any of the reasons stated above.
