For students seeking a well-rounded overview of the arts and sciences, Garrett College offers an Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree in general studies. This program is ideal for students who are undecided about a program of study. By majoring in general studies, students are able to explore a wide range of disciplines to assist them in determining a major.

To earn a general studies degree, students must complete 60 credit hours in the following areas:

- Communications
- Humanities
- Social Science
- Science
- Mathematics
- Computer Science

To enhance this degree, students are encouraged to transfer to a four-year college or university to complete a bachelor's degree. A transfer coordinator is available to assist with this transition, in addition to the student's academic advisor in the general studies program. Those students planning to attend Frostburg State University should enroll in Garrett College's general studies FSU transfer program.
