Beyond the theoretical, classroom-based instruction, Garrett's program features a required internship that provides hands-on, work-based experience in the sport management field. Garrett College is one of only three Maryland community colleges with a sport management program, and the only one in which a field experience is required.

On-campus field experiences are available, both through the College's Athletic Department and the Community Aquatic and Recreation Complex. Garrett's location is a prime opportunity for internship opportunities within the Deep Creek Lake area as well as nearby West Virginia and Pennsylvania.
