If you don't dance in public because you think you "have no rhythm," this is the class for you! Join us for two fun-filled hours of learning to dance on beat as Bob plays the drum and Jensuya teaches you the steps of the Eastern Mediterranean line dance called Debke (pronounced "deb key"). Debke is a group dance performed at family celebrations in the Levant (certain Eastern Mediterranean countries) and often performed on stage too. The class will cover the "vocabulary" of the steps, lifts, hops, weight transfers, etc. as we learn to differentiate the beat from the rhythm. Then we learn to layer on the steps in time with the rhythm as we dance in our group in a couple of different line formations. Along the way, we'll learn some keywords in Arabic, the language of Debke, and some of the history and lore of the dance. The course is best suited to adults, seniors, and children ages 10 and up. Please note that children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a participating adult. Wear clothes that you can move comfortably in and securely fastened sneakers/trainers (please do not wear flip flops or sandals). 

AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD

Lifeguard Certification w/CPR HM-288

The primary purpose of the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is to provide entry-level lifeguard participants with the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide professional-level care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services (EMS) personnel take over. Prerequisites: Minimum age: 15 years; Swim 300 yards continuously; Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs; Complete a timed event within 1 minute and 40 seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface dive to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, exit the water without using steps or a ladder. Participants who successfully complete the Lifeguarding course receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, valid for 2 years.

NOTE: The Lifeguard courses have an online blended learning component that will need to be completed the week prior to class. Courses are taught at the CARC in McHenry and instructed by Angela Luby.

Dr. Beachy has been an active collaborative pianist and composer for the past 17 years. Most recently, his work for concert band, Fanfare for an Uncommon Band, was premiered by the Garrett Community Concert Band, of which he is the director, in June 2022 celebrating the band's 20 th anniversary. 

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Course costs listed include tuition, fees, and out-of-county/outof-state differentials (where applicable). Costs listed for Maryland Senior Citizens (persons 60 years of age or older) include a tuition waiver (where applicable) and fees. All students are responsible for any materials or texts that may be required for all classes.

REFUND POLICY

Submission of a registration form and tuition and/or fee payment serves as confirmation of registration and results in the student being obligated for the cost of the course. If, for any reason, a student cannot attend the course for which they registered, it is their responsibility to withdraw from the course by calling 301-387-3069 or emailing the Program Coordinator directly. Refunds will be made in full if the student withdraws from a course prior to the registration deadline or closing date. If a student withdraws prior to the second class meeting, they may be eligible for a partial refund, but it is not guaranteed for all courses. There will be no refund after the second class session. Any requests for exemption to this policy must be made in writing and should be submitted to the Dean of Continuing Education & Workforce Development.

Garrett College's Continuing Education Workforce Development division awards over \$100,000 in scholarships annually as a result of funding from Garrett County Commissioners, local agencies, and private donors through the Garrett College Foundation. Full and partial scholarships are available based on the applicant's residency, educational goals and financial need. For best consideration, students are encouraged to apply early! Scholarship applications must be submitted at least three weeks prior to the start of selected program for consideration.

All workforce programs require a \$25 non-refundable application fee which cannot be paid with scholarship funds. The student is also responsible for any program fees, tests, or materials which are not covered by his/her scholarship.

Drop Policy

It is the student's responsibility to withdraw from a course that he/she cannot attend. Please note that failure to attend at least 75% of the course sessions, or failure to complete assigned coursework, may result in the termination of funding; as a result, the student will be charged for the entire cost of the course.



INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

WHEN ARE WEATHER-RELATED DECISIONS MADE?
