



The people and families impacted by the impoundment will be highlighted. The massive project of constructing the tunnels, dam, power house, roads, and bridges will also be covered. Participants will learn of mishaps and calamities of this fast-moving project. Lastly, some of the earliest views after the impoundment, just as the water was rising, will be presented. The Single Pitch Instructor (SPI) Program teaches climbing instructors to proficiently facilitate and instruct the sport of rock climbing in a single pitch setting. The SPI is the only internationally recognized single pitch climbing instructor certification program in the United States. It was developed to fit in the AMGA Rock program. Benefits:

The program is for current, active rock climbers who have a real desire to teach rock climbing to novices in a single pitch setting.

* The SPI Assessment (offered separately) is a minimum of 16 hours run over a two-day period.

Certification (earned by passing the SPI Assessment lasts for three years as long as the candidate keeps current AMGA Membership and appropriate First Aid Certification.

Course Prerequisites:

- You are a Professional Member of the AMGA.
- You have a genuine interest in rock climbing and instructing novices on single pitch crags.
- You are at least 18 years old at the time of the course.
- You have at least 12 months prior climbing experience.
- You are an active climber with traditional lead climbing experience (leader placing pro).
- You have led a minimum of 15 traditional rock climbing routes (any grade).
- You are capable of comfortably climbing 5.8 while on a top rope. This course will be held in the Coopers Rock State Forest and the surrounding area.



AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD

Lifeguard Certification w/CPR HM-288

The primary purpose of the American Red Cross Lifeguarding course is to provide entry-level lifeguard participants with the knowledge and skills to prevent, recognize, and respond to aquatic emergencies and to provide professional-level care for breathing and cardiac emergencies, injuries and sudden illnesses until emergency medical services (EMS) personnel take over. Prerequisites: Minimum age: 15 years; Swim 300 yards continuously; Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs; Complete a timed event within 1 minute and 40 seconds by starting in the water, swimming 20 yards, surface dive to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object, return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point, exit the water without using steps or a ladder. Participants who successfully complete the Lifeguarding course receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, valid for 2 years.

NOTE: The Lifeguard courses have an online blended learning component that will need to be completed the week prior to class. Courses are taught at the CARC in McHenry and instructed by Angela Luby.





Maryland Firearm Wear & Carry Permit Renewal PE - 049

This 8-hour hands-on shooting course is designed specifically for individuals seeking to renew their Maryland Handgun Wear & Carry Permit. The curriculum provides the knowledge and practical skills necessary to meet the training requirements mandated by the Maryland State Police for permit renewal. While successful completion of this course is required for renewal, it does not guarantee that a permit will be approved.

Students will receive a comprehensive review of firearm safety and Maryland firearms law, including use of force and legal responsibilities. The course also includes a live-fire qualification and practical instruction on handgun operation and shooting fundamentals.

What's Not Included:

- Maryland State Police application fee (currently \$50.00 – check or money order only)
- Ammunition (minimum of 25 rounds required; available from instructor at additional cost)
- Handgun (loaner firearms available upon request and subject to availability)

This 2-day class is required for anyone applying for the initial MD Wear & Carry Permit. Topics include: handgun nomenclature and operation, handgun action types, rules for safe firearm handling and use, fundamentals of handgun shooting, introduction to MD firearms laws, use of lethal force, selection/maintenance/storage of a handgun, home safety, interactions with law enforcement, and application requirements and process. Students should bring the firearm they will qualify with and 25 rounds of ammo to keep locked in trunk until arrival on range. Attendance of class does not guarantee permit. Additional charge for fingerprinting done on site.





Garrett College's Continuing Education Workforce Development division awards over \$100,000 in scholarships annually as a result of funding from Garrett County Commissioners, local agencies, and private donors through the Garrett College Foundation. Full and partial scholarships are available based on the applicant's residency, educational goals and financial need. For best consideration, students are encouraged to apply early! Scholarship applications must be submitted at least three weeks prior to the start of selected program for consideration.

All workforce programs require a \$25 non-refundable application fee which cannot be paid with scholarship funds. The student is also responsible for any program fees, tests, or materials which are not covered by his/her scholarship.

It is the student's responsibility to withdraw from a course that he/she cannot attend. Please note that failure to attend at least 75% of the course sessions, or failure to complete assigned coursework, may result in the termination of funding; as a result, the student will be charged for the entire cost of the course.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

WHEN ARE WEATHER-RELATED DECISIONS MADE?

Because weather and road conditions can change quickly, there is no fixed time by which a decision to delay or close is made. While we attempt to make decisions for all-day closings and delayed openings by 6:30 AM, you should always consider the possibility that the decision may come after that time. Decisions to close early are made based upon information about the conditions, which means that there is no set time that these decisions will be made either; however, the College attempts to have a decision made about closing early by 3:00 PM.

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH LOCATION IS CLOSED?

Announcements made that the College is closed due to weather conditions include all locations: McHenry campus, Northern Outreach Center (Grantsville), Career and Technical Training Center (Accident), and the Southern Outreach Center (Oakland). There may be times when a particular location is delayed or closed for reasons other than weather. The information that is disseminated at that time will specify which location(s) are affected.

Employees, students and the public should not call any college department to find out whether the college is closed or is going to close. We ask that you call the weather-line for closing or delayed opening information.

Note: The College will not make an announcement if operating on a regular schedule. If no information has been posted, then the College will be operating as normal
