Garrett College is pleased to offer basic literacy instruction, skills development, and high school diploma (GED) exam preparation classes.

New Ways to Earn Your High School Diploma



- Take the GED® Ready Practice Tests to determine if you are ready to take any of the four official GED® Exams. We will waive the \$6.00 per test fee.
- Classroom instruction offered at multiple locations and times
- Blended learning – combine distance/independent learning and classroom instruction
- National External Diploma Program (NEDP), a distance learning program, available to Garrett County residents in partnership with Allegany College of Maryland.
- Distance learning opportunities through Maryland i-Pathways

When are Classes Held?

- Day and evening classes available
- Classes will be offered in the evening at the locations listed above from 5:00-8:00p.m. and during the day in Oakland from 11:00a.m.-2:00p.m.

How much does it cost?

- The Adult Basic Education program is fully funded by the Maryland Department of Labor, Licensing and Regulation (DLLR) and Garrett College. As a result, **these classes are offered at no cost to the student.**
- To participate in Maryland i-Pathways and NEDP, the cost is \$150.
- To take the official GED® Exam, the cost is \$11.25 or \$45 for all four tests.
