Guidelines & Requirements.

Award(s) are open to individuals who:

- ❖ Have completed a FAFSA and a Scholarship Application and Essay
- ❖ Have and maintain a 2.5 College GPA minimum (Note: Spring awards for incoming freshmen could be revoked for low GPA)
- ❖ Are enrolled either full-time or part-time at Garrett College

If, in any year, no applicants meet all of the above criteria, the student who most closely fits the above criteria will be chosen. There is no limit to the number of years a qualified student may apply for the scholarship.

Applications must be received by August 24th and awards will be made August 31st.
