One \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded (\$2,500 per semester for Fall 2021/Spring 2022)

Qualifications: You must:

- Be a woman at least 2 years past a high school degree or a high school equivalency (GED);
- Be at least 20 years of age;
- Be accepted to an accredited educational or related academic program at an accredited institution, which will lead to a certificate of completion or degree; and
- Have lived, worked or attended school in Garrett County for at least the past 5 years.

To apply, you must:

- 1. Complete an application;
- 2. Provide a transcript if already attending;
- 3. Provide proof of enrollment in an accredited vocational, technical, or post-secondary school, college or university; and
- 4. Include two letters of reference.

Deadline: May 14, 2021
