Adventure Sports certified instructors will assist participants through drills to prepare participants for biking on single track trails for moderate to advance terrain. Participants must have 2 years mountain bike riding skills on single track trails to participate in day camps. Participants can use their own bikes if approved by instructors for safety purposes. **Mountain bikes, helmets and transportation included price.**
