Garrett College Background

- Established 1970, two-year community college
- Rural county of 30,000 residents
- Economically disadvantaged
- Enrollment growth 2006 to 2011, decline since
 - > Unduplicated headcount of 796 in FY18
- Revenue from tuition, state and county
- Transition in Institutional Leadership

 - present a recommendation which will enable the community college to meet its strategic goals over the plan period."


