UL – UL stands for upper-level junior/senior courses (300- or 400- level) & denotes the minimum upper-level credit that must be taken at UMGC for graduation Courses placed in the ELECTIVES/MINOR section may meet degree requirements depending on which course the student takes from the list of courses offered for the associate's degree. Any credit applied to the associate degree must also meet UMGC's transfer credit policy
