
It's all about **LOCATION**

Garrett College is an affordable, public two-year community college, located in scenic western Maryland near Deep Creek Lake, a four-season resort destination. Our 62-acre main campus in McHenry, MD, is approximately 15 miles south of I-68 off U.S. 219. We are two hours from Pittsburgh, PA, and just three hours from Washington, D.C.

We couldn't ask for a better location for our students to get out there and explore all the opportunities available to them. At Garrett College, our mountains, forests, lakes, and whitewater rivers become more than recreation activities, they become classrooms.

Students have the opportunity to participate in a variety of recreational sports, including skiing at nearby Wisp Resort; boating on 12-mile long Deep Creek Lake; biking or hiking on the 150 miles of forest trails in several state parks; rock climbing; or whitewater rafting on some of the best canoe, kayak, and rafting rivers in the United States and at the Adventure Sports Center International (ASCI) with its world-class competition course.

If you're not an outdoor enthusiast, not to worry - the Garrett County area offers plays, concerts, and other cultural events year-round.

At Garrett College, nature becomes the perfect backdrop for your learning experience, especially for our signature programs, **Adventure Sports Management** and **Natural Resources & Wildlife Technology**.

Our **Adventure Sports Management** program has earned an international reputation, allowing students to make careers out of being adventurous and doing what they love. Students learn about leadership development, program planning, managing risk, and making good decisions. Adventure sports majors now have the option to pursue a bachelor's degree in Adventure Sports Management from Frostburg State University through a partnership between GC and FSU.

Our **Natural Resources & Wildlife Technology** program presents the perfect opportunity for individuals who are passionate about hunting, hiking, fishing, or taking part in any nature-oriented activity in our rural environment. As part of the curriculum, students explore the wildlife habitats of southeast Arizona and the Chesapeake Bay, along with other regional environments.

These figures are estimates for the academic year based on 14 credit hours per semester and are subject to change by the Board of Trustees. The above estimates do not include books, supplies and personal expenses. Some courses may contain additional course fees. The housing estimate is based on a shared bedroom in Laker Hall and also includes a meal plan each semester.

STATEWIDE DESIGNATED

Garrett College currently has two programs of study that have received the status of Statewide-Designated: Adventure Sports Management (A.A.S. or Certificate) and Natural Resources & Wildlife Technology (A.A.S.). Full-time students enrolled in either of these programs are eligible to receive the in-county tuition rate.

WEST VIRGINIA RECIPROCITY


Residents in certain WV counties (Barbour, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Harrison, Marion, Mineral, Monongalia, Pendleton, Pocahontas, Preston, Randolph, Taylor, and Tucker) are eligible to receive in-county tuition for qualifying majors and programs of study.

BORDER RATE

Residents of Somerset and Fayette counties in PA and Preston, Tucker, Mineral and Grant counties in WV can now save about \$2,100 in tuition while earning an associate's degree from GC.

The two residence halls at Garrett College are intended to be a place for students to live on campus where they can work toward achieving their academic goals. Students have numerous opportunities to become involved in student life and activities, develop lifelong friendships, and make the most of their college experience.

Garrett College offers students two distinctive styles of residential living: traditional suite-style housing and two-and four-bedroom apartment-style housing. Both Garrett Hall and Laker Hall are just a short walk from the main campus and are conveniently located next to the Garrett College Community Aquatic & Recreation Complex (CARC), a state-of-the-art fitness facility. The CARC is home to all men's and women's basketball, women's volleyball and wrestling contests.

Students and their families often utilize an associate degree from Garrett College as a great cost-effective way to get started and lower the overall cost of their education.

Garrett College advisors assist students who wish to transfer to four-year institutions after graduation in order to complete a higher-level degree and maximize the number of credits that will transfer.

Advisors guide students in examining the transferability of credits to other colleges and/or universities. Garrett College maintains articulation agreements with several institutions that offer outstanding transfer scholarships to associate degree students.

Representatives from these institutions frequently visit campus to meet individually with transfer-minded students, offering on-the-spot admissions decisions, transcript evaluations, and waived application fees.
